RULES

1. Under no circumstances must horses/ponies be left unattended unless securely boxed and must not be left tethered in the vicinity of the show ring or to the outside of vehicles.
2. Horses, ponies and riders age as of 1st January in the current year.
3. The Judge's decision is final. Any confrontation with a judge is strictly forbidden.
4. Competitors and spectators must conduct themselves in an orderly manner. Any use of bad language or behaviour which may bring the club into disrepute will result in disciplinary action.
5. CHILDREN MUST BE KEPT UNDER ADULT CONTROL.
6. No unauthorised person(s) are allowed in the ring at any time.
7. Points trophies will be awarded in each class to the competitor gaining most points over the same season with the same horse/pony/rider/handler combination. Points will only be awarded for the April, May, June and July shows. (Double points will be awarded in July). The August show is an open show (no points to be awarded). Competitors need to attend a minimum of TWO shows to be eligible for points awards.
8. All lead rein competitors must be led by an adult (16 years and over). The lead rein must be attached to the noseband NOT the bit.
9. All ridden horses & ponies competing must be 4 years old and over. All competitors must be of a suitable size and weight for the horse/pony they are riding.
10. All competitors must be correctly dressed whilst mounted, leading and in the ring. British Standard hard hats must be worn. Chin straps and jackets must be fastened correctly. Arms must be covered. Correct footwear must be worn. Body protectors may be worn.
11. All dogs must be on a lead and kept under control. PLEASE CLEAN UP AFTER THEM.
12. NO RESPONSIBILITY IS ACCEPTED BY CAVERSWALL & DISTRICT RIDING CLUB FOR ANY ACCIDENT, INJURY OR LOSS OF PROPERTY REGARDLESS OF HOW THIS IS CAUSED.
13. CAVERSWALL & DISTRICT RIDING CLUB REQUIRE THAT ALL COMPETITORS MUST CARRY PUBLIC LIABILITY INSURANCE WITH A MINIMUM OF THIRD-PARTY COVER.
14. Stallions must be handled by a person (14 Years and over for large breeds and 12 years and over for small breeds) and be correctly bitted. Riders of small breeds must be 12 years old and over. All stallions/colts must be correctly bitted at all times whilst on the showground. Riders of large breeds must be 14 years old and over.
15. Points will be deemed void should any monies (including trophies) be outstanding to the club.
16. Anyone attending the shows is asked to place litter in the bins provided or take it home. PLEASE.....poo-pick, there is equipment provided.
17. No spurs to be worn for riders age 16 or below and in novice/beginners classes.
18. The miss use of spurs is an offence and if used (seniors) you must take care that the manner in which they are used does not offend
19. Whips to be no longer than 75cm (30 inches)
20. No visible body piercings to be worn, if seen you will be asked to remove them.
21. Competitors need to attend a minimum of TWO shows to be eligible for points awards.

22. Abuse to any committee member will not be tolerated and bad language is unacceptable from anyone.
23. Complaints to be made in writing no later than 30 minutes after completion of the class with a deposit of £40. The complaint will be reviewed at the next committee meeting and if upheld the money will be refunded.
24. Points can only be accumulated from the date of membership.
25. Membership to close at the June Show.
26. Please head to our website to find advice and guidance on dress code and conduct in the show ring.

RIDDEN SHOWING - Judge Mr. Les Shaw

CLASS 9 - RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL.

Open to all small breeds incl. Shetlands. Riders any age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 10 - RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE.

Open to all large breeds. Riders any age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 11 - RIDDEN PLAITED COLOURED, SPOTTED, PALOMINO OR DUN. Open to all plaited coloured horses/ponies. Riders any age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 12 - RIDDEN COB. Open to all cobs, incl. Traditional. Rider any age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 13 - RIDDEN COLOURED NATIVE COB & TRADITIONAL.

Open to all Native, Cob & Traditional type coloured horses/ponies. Riders any age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 14 - RIDDEN SHOW HORSE. Open to all plaited horses exceeding 148cm. Riders and age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 15 - RIDDEN HUNTER. Open to all plaited hunter types exceeding 153cm. Riders and age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 16 - RIDDEN VETERAN. Class will be split into 2 sections: 16A 14-19 years, 16B 20+ Years. Riders any age, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 17 - SENIOR EQUITATION. Riders to have attained their 18th Birthday by the 1st Jan in the current year. Horse/Pony and height, snaffle bridle only

RING 2- Large grass outdoor arena - Start 9am

IN HAND SHOWING CLASSES - Judge Mr. Les Shaw

CLASS 18 - IN HAND YOUNG STOCK. Open to any type, yearlings, two year and three year olds. Highest Placed Yearling Rosette. Stallions/Colts must be correctly bited and handled by competent exhibitors - No Children
Top 2 from each age section will go forward to the Youngstock Championship in the Evening Performance

CLASS 19 - IN HAND SHETLAND & MINIATURES

CLASS 20 - IN HAND MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND SMALL.
Open to all M & M Small Breed Types incl. Shetlands.

CLASS 21 - IN HAND MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND LARGE.
Open to all M & M Large Breed Types.

CLASS 22 - IN HAND COLOURED, SPOTTED, PALOMINO & DUN. Open to all coloured Horses/Ponies.

CLASS 23 - IN HAND COB. Open to all Cobs incl. Traditional.

CLASS 24 - OPEN IN HAND. Open to all horses/ponies.

CLASS 25 - IN HAND PLAITED HORSE/PONY. Horses exceeding 148cm, Ponies 148cm and under. Class will be split for Horses and Ponies.

CLASS 26 - IN HAND VETERAN. Class will be split into two sections: 26A 14-19 years, 26B 20+ years.

RING 2- Large grass outdoor arena

WORKING HUNTER CLASSES - Judge Mrs J Hampton

CLASS 27 - NURSERY STAKES. Pony to be 128cm and under, riders not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan in current year. Max 40cm

CLASS 28 - M & M WORKING HUNTER PONY. Class may be split depending on entries and points for STARS. Small Breeds 60cm, Large Breeds 75cm Max

CLASS 29 - WORKING HUNTER PONY. Under 133cm - 65cm, 133cm - 153cm 75cm max. Class will be split for points and STARS.

CLASS 30 - WORKING HUNTER HORSE.WORKING HUNTER HORSE. Horses exceeding 153cm, jump height 85-90cm max

CLASS 31 - RIDING CLUB HORSE/PONY. Riders any age, one jump to be included in the individual show.

RING 3- Mini Showing - Indoor Arena - 9.00 am Start

MINI SHOWING - Judge: Mr Neil Harrison

CLASS 32 - LEAD REIN PLAITED PONY. Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm. Snaffle bridle only. LR attached to the noseband.

CLASS 33 - FIRST RIDDEN PLAITED PONY. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm. Snaffle bridle only.

CLASS 34 - LEAD REIN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND. Rider not to have attained their 10th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm. Snaffle bridle only.

CLASS 35 - FIRST RIDDEN MOUNTAIN & MOORLAND. Rider not to have attained their 12th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 36 - TINY TOTS HANDLER. Handlers must have attained their 4th birthday but not their 8th birthday before the 1st Jan in the current year. Ponies not to exceed 128cm, handlers must be accompanied by an adult in the ring, but not assist the handler unless in difficulty. Ponies must be suitable for children.

CLASS 37 - YOUNG HANDLER. Handlers must have attained their 8th birthday but not their 12th birthday before the 1st Jan in the current year. Horse/Pony any height.

RIDDEN SHOWING - Judge : Mr Neil Harrison

CLASS 38 - JUNIOR HANDLER. Handlers to have attained their 12th birthday but not their 18th before the 1st Jan in the current year. Horse/Pony any height.

CLASS 39 - PRE NOVICE WALK & TROT. Open to horses/ponies, riders any age. Walk & Trot Only

CLASS 40 - NOVICE WALK, TROT & CANTER. Open to Horses/Ponies, riders any age. Walk & Trot with Canter in individual shows only.

CLASS 41 - RIDDEN SHOW PONY. Rider any age, open to all plaited show ponies not exceeding 148cm, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 42 - JUNIOR EQUITATION. Riders not to have attained their 18th birthday before 1st Jan in the current year. Horse/Pony any height, snaffle bridle only.

CLASS 43- SHOW HUNTER PONY. Rider any age, open to all plaited hunter ponies not exceeding 153cm, any suitable bridle.

CLASS 44 - FANCY DRESS Open to Horses and Ponies. 50th Golden Anniversary Theme.

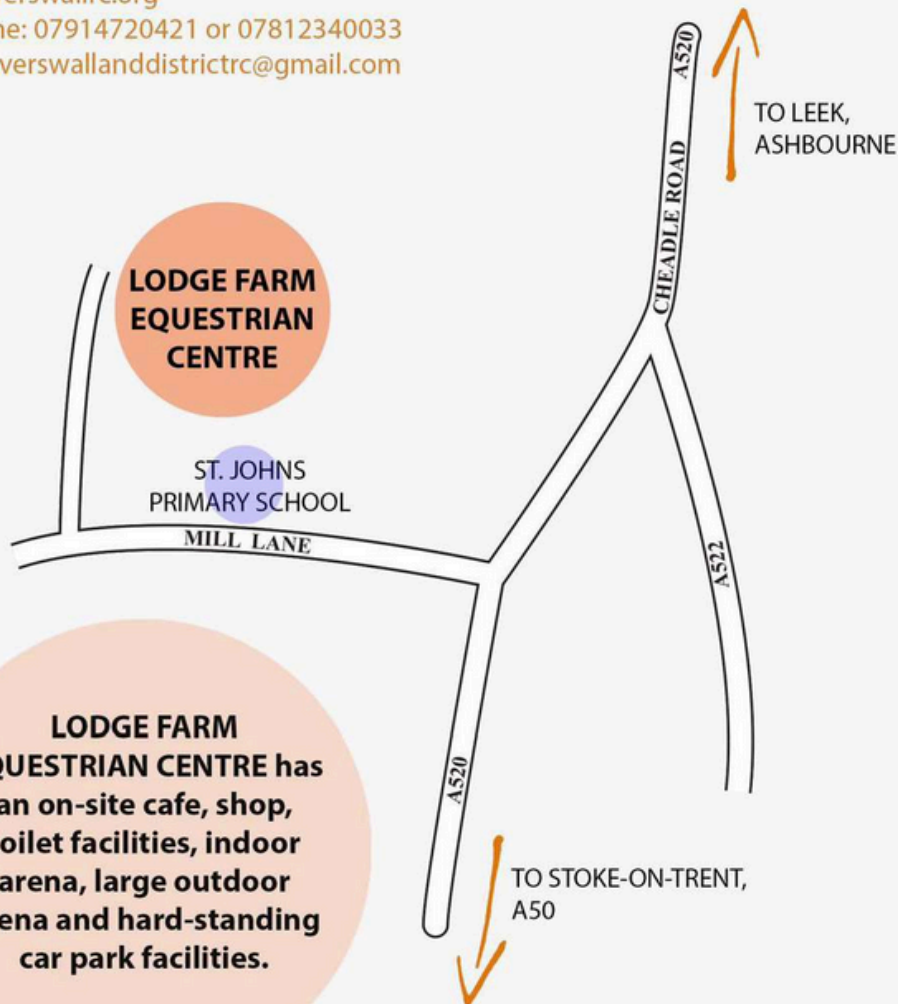
